Last month we kicked off the spring season by visiting the wonderful Greenwich Historical Society. We spent the afternoon exploring the Permanent Collections Gallery which showcases works by members of the Cos Cob art colony. The fascinating collection is comprised of objects that both connect to and convey the history of the Town of Greenwich and Bush-Holley Historic Site, the home of Connecticut's first Impressionist art colony at the turn of the 20th century.

Our docent walked us through the collection's objects that date from the 18th through the 20th century. These unique objects document the culture of present and former inhabitants of Greenwich and its region. We learned the rich history of various fine and decorative arts; maritime, agricultural, industrial and domestic artifacts; costumes and textiles; and paintings by artists who once boarded at or visited the Bush-Holley House. We're very excited to return soon for the featured exhibitions in the coming weeks and months!
